APPLICATION ELIGIBILITY AND REQUIREMENTS UNDERGRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM 2005

Applications Must Be Received NLT Friday, February 3, 2006

A. Eligibility

1. Applicant must have one full year of course work completed and one full year of course work remaining at the beginning of the Fall 2005 term in a two, four or five year program.
2. Applicant must desire a career in construction.
3. Applicant must pursue a degree in a construction related program, such as construction management, civil engineering, architectural engineering technology or related programs. A dual degree with construction or construction/civil engineering as one part is acceptable.
4. Applicant must be a U.S. citizen.

B. Requirements

1. Applicant is responsible for ensuring that all of the following items are submitted as one package and received NLT February 3, 2006.
 - a. Complete and signed application.
 - b. Three letters of recommendation.
 - c. Transcripts.
2. **Recipient(s) must be able to attend ACI's Annual Meeting held on March 23, 2006.**

C. Awards

1. Scholarships will be a maximum of \$1,000 per recipient.
2. Applications will be reviewed and recipients selected by the ACI Scholarship Committee, which will consider the applicant's interest in construction, grades, extracurricular activities, employment experience, letters of recommendation and financial status.
3. All applicants selected as semi-finalists will be subject to a personal interview with a representative or representatives of the ACI Scholarship Committee. Semi-finalists will be notified NLT March 2, 2006.
4. Award(s) will be presented at the ACI Annual Meeting, held on March 23, 2006. Recipients will be notified by mail. Again, **the recipient's presence at this meeting is mandatory.**
5. Checks will be given directly to the recipient(s) and made payable to both the recipient and college or university to ensure the money is used for tuition and/or books. Checks will not be sent to the recipient's college or university.
